

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, June 11, 2015 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, June 11, 2015 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Chuck Bagley, Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Mike Jones, Mark Kiddoo and Rey Martinez were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:32pm.

Doug Monda gave the invocation and Council Member Mark Kiddoo led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

1. Last Month's Minutes
2. Last Month's Financial Report
3. Approval to allow the Mayor to sign Retirement Plan Changes - re: 10 year vesting of new employees
4. Year End Budget Amendments
5. Vehicle Purchase - CID - \$29,663.99
6. Authorization for Mayor to sign contract for Police Reporting Software and approve expense
7. Water Sewer Materials Contract - Ferguson Waterworks Supply
8. Concrete Services Contract - Southern Concrete and Finishing
9. Chemical Supplier Contract - Polytec, Inc.
10. Digester Replacement Pump - \$26,679.98
11. Paving Repairs - City Hall Parking Lot (\$7,861) and Camp Street (\$19,983)

Council Member Chuck Bagley seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to table the amendment of the Land Development Ordinance as it related to automotive sales in order to hold a joint meeting between the Planning Commission and the Planning and Development Committee and to extend the moratorium an additional 60 days allowing the Mayor permission to sign moratorium extension to be prepared by City Attorney Robyn Webb. Council Member Chuck Bagley seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the FYE 6/30/2016 Budget and Appropriations Ordinance as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to table discussion of the training policy for elected officials until no sooner than January 2016. Motion died for a lack of a second.

Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to deny the training policy for elected officials as presented. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. After much discussion, vote was 3-3 with Council Members Rey Martinez, Mark Kiddoo and Jay Boland voted in favor of the motion and Council Members Chuck Bagley, Skip Baliles and Mike Jones voting in opposition. Mayor Dan Curry broke the tie voting in favor of the motion to deny the training policy for elected officials.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to award the CDBG Fox Chase paving contract to Allied Paving Contractors for \$313,400.00. Council Member Chuck Bagley seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to allow the City to re-join the Gwinnett Urban County CDBG Program. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign the documents related to the City re-joining the Gwinnett Urban County CDBG Program. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

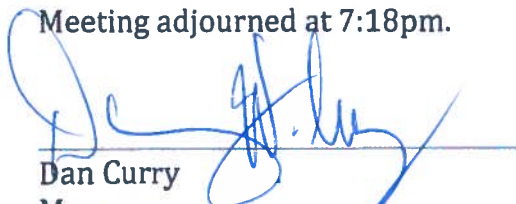

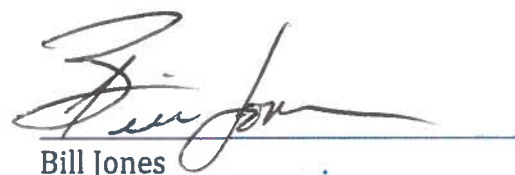
