Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, August 13, 2015 at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Chuck Bagley, Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Mike Jones and Mark Kiddoo were all present. Council Member Rey Martinez was unable to attend.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:33pm.

The Pastor of Morning Star Baptist Church gave the invocation. The pledge to the flag was led by Boy Scouts from Troop #582.

Council Member Chuck Bagley made a motion to amend the agenda to include a recognition. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the consent agenda as follows:

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the 2015-2016 SRO Contract with Walton County Board of Education. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the Annual Drinking Water Fee Invoice for \$10,640. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to accept the letter from Dwight Harrison, Loganville Beverage Center regarding his license for a third package store. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the proposed Alcohol Amendment to eliminate the third liquor store. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion failed 2-3 with Council Members Chuck Bagley, Jay Boland and Mike Jones voting in opposition.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to deny the propose Amendment to the Alcohol Ordinance to allow sales until 2am. Motion died for a lack of a second.

Council Member Chuck Bagley made a motion to approve the Alcohol Amendment to allow sales until 2am. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-1 with Council Member Mike Jones voting in opposition.

With no further business, Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
