Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, October 10, 2013 7:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met on Thursday, October 10, 2013 at 7:30pm in the Council Chambers for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Mike Jones, Mark Kiddoo, Michelle Lynch and Rey Martinez were all present.

Mayor Curry called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

WQC Director Chris Yancey gave the invocation and members of the American Legion Riders led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to remove the Grant Application with ARC for Electric Charging Stations from the agenda and approve the agenda with the modification. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-1 with Council Member Skip Baliles voting in opposition.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve last month's minutes as presented. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the Drop Box Ordinance as presented. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve a 90 extension of the moratorium on applications for RM4, RM6 and RM8 zoning. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the Walton County Chamber of Commerce Contract and requested a quarterly update from the Chamber. Council Member Michelle Lynch seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to approve the purchase of 2 new laser units for the police department for \$5,615.00. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve allowing parking only on one side of the street on Huntington Drive on Halloween night for the safety of children out trick or treating. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve The Cross Church 5K run to be held on November 16, 2013. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the annual contracts with Precision Paving, (Asphalt Paving), Ferguson Water Works Supplies (Water & Sewer Materials), Southern Concrete and Finishing (Concrete Services) and Polytec Inc (Chemical Supplier). Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the Church Street Project at a cost of \$38,788.00. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Jay Boland made a motion to approve the purchase of 5,100 water meters for a total cost of \$350,000 to be funded from SPLOST proceeds. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.



Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to approve an amendment to Section 4-63 of the Alcohol Ordinance adding that new construction of a retail package stores be required to be open for business within 12 months after the completion of the appeal process pertaining to applications for licenses also allowing for extensions due to inclement weather. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the surplus auction to be held November 9, 2013 at 10:00am. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
