

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Called Council Meeting
Friday, February 22, 2013 10:00am
Council Chambers

The City Council for the City of Loganville met on Friday, February 22, 2013 at 10:00am at City Hall for a Called Council Meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to take action on the Mayor's Veto of Case #R12-005. Mayor Ray Nunley and Council Members Skip Baliles, Dan Curry, Mike Jones, Mark Kiddoo and Michelle Lynch were all present. Council Member Rey Martinez was absent due to military leave.

Mayor Nunley called the meeting to order at 10:00am.

City Attorney Karen Woodward presented the Mayor's Veto to the Council for action. She explained that to overturn the Mayor's veto the Council needed to make a motion to do so. She explained that if no motion were made on the matter then the Mayor's veto would stand. There was no motion, therefore the Mayor's motion stands. (A copy of the veto is attached for the record.)

City Manager Bill Jones presented a letter to the Mayor and Council from Attorney David Gussio regarding the applications for Case #R12-005 and #V12-006. Mr. Jones explained that he requested on behalf of the applicants to withdraw the applications suggesting that the Council consider excluding the possible twelve (12) month waiting period for re-filing of the applications. Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the request of the applicant to withdraw the applications for Case #R12-005 and #V12-006. Council Member Dan Curry seconded the motion. Council Member Mike Jones asked Council Member Michelle Lynch to amend her motion to include the 12 month waiting period. There was discussion regarding the 12 month waiting period. Planning Director Tim Prater explained that with a withdrawal of an application there was not an automatic 12 month period imposed and if so desired by the Mayor and Council it would need to be included by motion. Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to impose the 12 month waiting period on re-submittal of these applications. Council Member Dan Curry seconded the motion. Council Member Mark Kiddoo stated that he didn't have a problem with the waiting period either way but he didn't see why it would be necessary because he felt like it would take some time for them to complete their plans. Council Member Skip Baliles stated that since their letter stated that the withdrawal is not contingent upon the waiting period that he felt like the City should approve the 12 month waiting period. Motion regarding the waiting period to re-file an application for rezoning or for a variance carried 3-2 with Council Members Mark Kiddoo and Michelle Lynch voting in opposition. Motion on the original motion to approve the withdrawal carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Dan Curry made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Meeting adjourned at 10:17am.
