

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE Called Council Meeting Wednesday, March 27, 2013 9:00 a.m. Council Chambers

The City of Loganville City Council met for a special Called Council Meeting on Wednesday, March 27, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. Vice Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Mike Jones, Mark Kiddoo and Michelle Lynch were present. Council Member Rey Martinez joined the meeting via phone from active duty service.

Vice Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 9:05am.

After a moment of silence in honor of Mayor Ray Nunley, City Manager Bill Jones gave an invocation and the pledge to the flag was led.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Vice Mayor Dan Curry presented a letter from Mayor Nunley resigning his office as Mayor due to health reasons. Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to accept the resignation of Mayor Nunley. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Elections Superintendent Kristi Ash discussed the holding of a special election to fill the unexpired term of Mayor Nunley. She explained that the Special Election would be held on Tuesday, June 18th and we would need to hold qualifying for the position. She also explained that should anyone on the Council wish to seek the Mayor's position a special election would also need to be held to fill that person's unexpired term. She further explained that both elections could be held at the same time and on the same ballot. There was discussion regarding this matter. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to hold qualifying for the unexpired term of Mayor Nunley beginning at 8:30am on Monday, April 8th through 12:00pm pm Wednesday, April 10th. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to allow Vice Mayor Dan Curry to assume the responsibilities of the Mayor as provided for under the Charter. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Vice Mayor Dan Curry announced that he intended to qualify for the Mayor's seat. City Attorney Karen Woodward explained that this would mean that in order to have a quorum under the Charter that it would require Council Member Ray Martinez's presence via phone at all subsequent meetings. There was discussion. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to resend his previous motion regarding qualifying. Council Member Mike Jones seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to hold qualifying for the unexpired term of Mayor Nunley beginning at 8:30am on Monday, April 15th through 12:00pm pm Wednesday, April 17th. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

With no further discussion, Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Meeting adjourned at 9:25am.
