

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, April 11, 2013 7:30 p.m.
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, April 11, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. Acting Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members; Skip Baliles, Mike Jones, Mark Kiddoo and Michelle Lynch were present. Council Member Rey Martinez was not present to do active duty service obligations.

Acting Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Pastor Brent Ross gave the invocation and Cub Scouts from Pack 55 led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve last month's financial report as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch reported that appeals hearing were held for the package store applications and she wanted to thank everyone for their work. Council Member Michelle Lynch also announced that the Zoning Commission would hold a meeting on April 25th at 7:30pm.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo announced that FYE 6-30-2014 Budget Hearings would be held on May 3, 2013 at 11am and May 6, 2013 at 6pm. He also announced that the Finance Committee would meet prior to these dates and everyone would be notified once the meeting has been set.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to table the repairs / water proofing of the Gwinnett County Fire Station to allow for the review of additional bids for 30 days. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the application and request by the American Legion Riders to hold the 3rd Ride for America on May 27th. Council Member Mike Jones seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Acting Mayor Dan Curry announced that services related to the National Day of Pray would be held at City Hall on May 2, 2013 beginning at noon.

Council Member Michelle Lynch announced that orders are being accepted for Veteran's Bricks. She explained that bricks would be order in the spring to be laid in the fall by Veteran's Day. She also announced that the cost of the bricks is \$40 and order forms may be obtained at City Hall.

Council Member Michelle Lynch announced that applications are currently being accepted for vendors for the Independence Day Celebration. Applications and information can be obtained at www.independencedaycelebration.com.

Acting Mayor Dan Curry presented the contract with McFarland, Dyer for the rebidding of the Brand Road CDBG at a reduced cost of \$4,800. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve this contract. Council Member Mike Jones seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to purchase a new 2653 John Deer lawn mower for the Public Works Department at a cost of \$6,500. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mike Jones also updated the Council that the electrical work has been completed on the Cown Drive project. He explained that we should be able to purchase the light sometime next week.

Acting Mayor Dan Curry presented Angela Yarman with a proclamation in support of Communities in School proclaiming May 3rd Communities in Schools Day in Loganville.

City Manager Bill Jones announced that instead of the regular monthly meeting of the Walton Municipal they would be holding a joint work session with the Council to work on the comprehensive plan.

City Manager Bill Jones announced that the City is working on raising funds for Relay for Ray and encouraged everyone to get involved.

City Attorney Karen Woodward announced that we would not be holding a lottery for the issuance of package store license. She announced that after the hearings one license was awarded to Donald Harrison in Walton County and Highway 78 Real Estate, LLC in Gwinnett County. She also explained that we have been notified by Buddy Balance, LLC that they would be filing an appeal with the Superior Court based on their denial.

Acting Mayor Dan Curry presented his resignation effective April 15th in order to qualify for the position of Mayor. Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to accept his resignation. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


Acting Mayor Dan Curry appointed Council Member Skip Baliles as Public Utilities Chairman.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to appoint Mark Kiddoo as Vice Mayor. Council Member Mike Jones seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
