Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, May 9, 2013 7:30pm
Council Chambers



The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, May 9, 2013 at 7:30pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Acting Mayor Mark Kiddoo and Council Members Skip Baliles, Mike Jones and Michelle Lynch were also present. Council Member Rey Martinez was present via cell phone from Active Duty Service.

Acting Mayor Mark Kiddoo called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Pastor David Gravitt gave the invocation and Scouts from Troop #536 led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve last month's minutes. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to approve last month's financial report. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Fire Chief Danny Roberts recognized Sgt. Andy Freeman and Lt. Andy Logan for their efforts in saving a gentleman's life.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to return Case #A13-005 – Town & Country Pet Salon to the Planning Commission for further review and to determine if this project is compatible with our current Land Use Plan. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to return Case #R13-006 – Town & Country Pet Salon to the Planning Commission for further review and to determine if this project is compatible with our current Land Use Plan. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to return Case #V13-007 – Town & Country Pet Salon to the Planning Commission for further review and to determine if this project is compatible with our current Land Use Plan. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to adopt the Short Term Work Program Resolution as presented. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the bid from Metro Water Proofing for the repairs to the Gwinnett Fire Station for \$8,476. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to allow the Police Department to purchase a new patrol car with forfeited funds. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion to approve the purchase of a Live Scan machine from Eagle Solutions for \$16,400. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to allow the Police Department to purchase an additional patrol car with funding from the SDS Settlement from Gwinnett County to replace another high mileage vehicle. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve necessary repairs to the SCADA system for \$32,792. Council Member Mike Jones seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


Council Member Michelle Lynch made a motion that the pavilion at Town Green be named the Ray Nunley Pavilion. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Mike Jones made a motion to approve the bid from Hamby Construction for \$84,989 for the construction of the pavilion and to allow the City Manager the authority to negotiate any changes or additions necessary up to \$100,000. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.


