

MINUTES

CITY OF LOGANVILLE
Regular Council Meeting
Thursday, September 8, 2016 6:30pm
Council Chambers

The City of Loganville Mayor and Council met for their regularly scheduled Council Meeting on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at 6:30pm. Mayor Dan Curry and Council Members Skip Baliles, Jay Boland, Linda Dodd, Mark Kiddoo and Rey Martinez were all present.

Mayor Dan Curry called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

Rev. Mickey Oliver (New Testament Baptist Church) gave the invocation and Council Member Mark Kiddoo led the pledge to the flag.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to remove the Gwinnett County Water Contract and adopt the agenda with this correction. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Linda Dodd made a motion to adopt last month's minutes as presented. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to adopt last month's financial report as presented. Council Member Jay Boland seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Planning and Zoning Case #R16-010 was presented to the Council. Victory Baptist Church has requested to rezone approximately 24.99 acres located at 150 Clark McCullers Road from R-44 to CH for the relocation of Victory Baptist Church and School. Pastor Derik Lawrence was present to represent Victory Baptist Church. There was no opposition to this case. Chief Danny Roberts stated that whichever side is not occupied at this time will be blocked off from access to any children or staff. The building must be brought up to code before occupying. Additionally, this would apply to all adjacent buildings or structures. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the case with the condition and understanding that either the old or new portion of the building and the area that is not to be occupied at this time will be blocked off from access until it is brought up to code. This condition will also apply to any accessory structure on the property (concession stand, ball fields, etc). Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Planning and Zoning Case #R16-011 was presented to the Council. Victory Baptist Church has requested to rezone approximately 10.12 acres located at 150 Clark McCullers Road from R-44 to CH for the relocation of Victory Baptist Church and School. Pastor Derik Lawrence was present to represent Victory Baptist Church.

There was no opposition to this case. Chief Danny Roberts stated that whichever side is not occupied at this time will be blocked off from access to any children or staff. The building must be brought up to code before occupying. Additionally, this would apply to all adjacent buildings or structures. Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve the case with the condition and understanding that either the old or new portion of the building and the area that is not to be occupied at this time will be blocked off from access until it is brought up to code. This condition will also apply to any accessory structure on the property (concession stand, ball fields, etc). Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to approve life insurance for retirees to be paid for by the retiree. Council Member Mark Kiddoo seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Skip Baliles made a motion to allow retirees to have the opportunity to continue their health care coverage if they retire by meeting the rule of 80 after the age 60 and be allowed to continue coverage until age 65 or until eligible for Medicare whichever comes first. Additionally, increases to rates will be borne by the employees the same as regular employees. Council Member Linda Dodd seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.



Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to approve the 2016 OPEB valuation at a cost of \$6,925. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Council Member Mark Kiddoo made a motion to deny the rate increase proposed by Advanced Disposal. Council Member Rey Martinez seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

With no further business, Council Member Rey Martinez made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Skip Baliles seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
